# Stand Together for Tolerance

16 June – 26 June 2015

We live today in a society where the different social classes don't mix. In general people live in a well defined place depending on origins, social classes, political or sexual orientations, gender, food preferences, etc.

Evolving in a certain social standing doesn't allow us to develop tolerance and respect towards differences, we believe that meeting and living with different people is the best way to fight discriminations.

### OUR AIM

The main goal of this TC is to improve the inclusion of marginalized people in our European societies. We wish to increase the citizen fight against the discriminations.

During this TC, we will meet different organizations or people who are fighting in their everyday life to include, accept and empower marginalized people : disabled people, prisoners, unemployed people, youth with social difficulties, immigrant (undocumented or not), homosexuals, etc.

With those organizations and people, we will organize practical and playful activities to create links between the participants and the people we will meet. We will work with them on a common goal and create a common experience.

### METHODS

Participative methods will be used. The participants will have to be active and involved in every workshop and get them to think, analyze and debate. By this tool, they will learn knowledge and know-how passed on during the training.

### VENUE AND DATE

The training will take place during 11 days at Montbrun-Bocage (South-West of France), in a “holiday cottage” rented by our organization.

There will be around 25 participants.

The training will take place from the 16<sup>th</sup> to the 26<sup>th</sup> of June (travels days included).

### PROGRAMME

Concerning the activities, so far, there will be:

- Visit of a center who welcome asylum seekers
- Discovering theater of the oppressed
- Visit of an organization that fights against racism
