One moderator remains at the table; while others change clockwise, yet stay in the same group. **7 minutes** per topic. Afterwards, the moderators present what was discussed (1-2 minutes each). Topics:

1. What are the most important things/venues/institutions for youth in big cities? Why?
2. Do you think that there are great differences between what young people and adults (over 30s) needs in/from their cities? If so what are they? and what are the ways to make everyone satisfied?
3. Would you say that the current practices of youth participation in decision-making are enough/are working? How the situation can be improved?
4. Do you think that big cities can benefit from immigration? What are the pros and cons?
5. What (if any) are the main challenges that most youngsters face in big cities? Are there any ways (i.e. special initiatives) to help them deal with these problems?
6. Perfect city environment. How should it look like? What makes cities open/welcoming?
