What About Village?

- They grew up in german villages, and they think villages are good places, people are friendly.
- They moved mostly for studying and working. Better opportunities
- They consider the possibility to move back to village in the future, since it offers a better environment for growing up children and for living
- Direct experience of villages



What About Village?

- From the city, he thinks villages are not suited for him because of scarce opportunities.
- Alcoholism
- He would not move to village, on the contrary he would love to go abroad in a bigger city (Berlin...)
- Just thoughts and perception of villages



What About Village?

- From the village, with family still there. Really positive opinion about village and villagers.
- In the city for work, she dreams to go back to the village because of the higher quality of life, bigger spaces.
- Wooden houses, each one distant from the other, big gardens, animals, limited transportation. Village are changing.
- Direct experience of villages



What About Village?

- From the city, negative opinion. Village are just for holidays. Only positive aspect: no police!
- They do not want to go to village, they are boring and for old people.
- No shops, no pubs, no fun, nothing
- Just experienced villages during holidays



Final conclusions

- Stereotype from the city: alcoholism, boring, few opportunities and services
- People from village want to go back in the villages in the future. Better quality of life, nature, no stress, spaces, different activities/works
