Roles:

- You are 14 years old boy who lives near the war zone

- You are the daughter of the local bank manager

- You are a single mother with 2 children living in a East Ukraine

- You are happy, married woman with 3 children and husband living in Germany

- You are 28 years old ukrainian woman who lives abroad without knowing local language

- You are 23 year old girl who is studying in the university and living in Norway

- You are 45 years old man whose house was destroyed by explosion

- You are 33 years old single woman working at local municipality.

- You are 15 years old ukrainian girl who had to move to live to other city because of the war

- You are privileged 19 years old boy who just finished high school and now traveling around the world

- You are a 25 years old refugee from Syria who lives in small flat in Sweden.

- You are the son of the parents who are rich and have their own business.

Questions:

1. You have adequate social and medical protection for your needs, *take one step forward*.
2. You feel that you can study and follow the profession of your choice, *take one step forward*.
3. You have never felt discriminated against because of your origin, *take one step forward*.
4. You have never faced any serious financial difficulties, *take one step forward*.
5. You have had peaceful and enjoyable childhood, *take one step forward*.
6. You have the same opportunity like everybody else to get well-paid job in the country that you are living now, *take one step forward*.
7. If you have ever felt unsafe walking alone at night, take one step backward
8. If you have been the victim of physical violence based on your ethnicity, take one step backward.
9. If you feel good about how your identified culture is portrayed by the media, *take one step forward*.
10. If there have been times in your life when you skipped a meal because there was no food in the house, take one step backward
11. If you have ever felt passed over for an employment position based on your ethnicity, take one step backward.

12. If you were generally able to avoid places that were dangerous, *take one step forward*.
13. If you were ever ashamed or embarrassed of your clothes, house, car, etc. take one step back.
14. If you were raised in an area where there was political conflicts, war, take one step back.
15. If you attended private school or summer camp, *take one step forward*
16. If you were paid less, treated less fairly because of ethnicity, take one step back

17. If you were ever accused of cheating or lying because of your ethnicity, take one step back.
18. If your parents told you that you could be anything you wanted to be, *take one step forward*.
19. If you have health insurance, *take one step forward*.
20. If you did not have opportunities to choose what you want to do in your life, take one step back.
