1. Which country currently hosts the most refugees?

- **Turkey**
- Afghanistan
- Lebanon

According to the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), Turkey hosts 2,5 million refugees within its borders. Pakistan is the second largest host country, at 1,6 million.

2. What percentage of the world's refugees is hosted by developing nations?

- 35%
- 50%
- **80%**
- 10%

According to the UN Refugees Agency, there is a disproportionate support for the world's displaced, with the developing world shouldering most of the burden. "The burden of helping the world's forcibly displaced is starkly uneven," UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon said. "Poor countries host vastly more displaced people than wealthier ones."

3. Most refugees come from which three countries?

In June 2016, CNN reported that 54% of the world's refugees are from Syria, Afghanistan, and Somalia.

4. How many people have been forcibly displaced worldwide?

There are 65,3 million people displaced globally - that's more than the number of people displaced after WWII. According to UNHCR report, nearly 22 million of those are refugees and 10 million more are stateless.

5. What is the total number of Syrian refugees to date?

There are nearly five million refugees from Syria, and more than six million are internally displaced by violence (UNHCR).

6. Which African country has welcomed the most refugees?

- Uganda
- Kenya

According to Africa Renewal, Ethiopia overtook Kenya as Africa's largest refugee host country, with approximately 700,000 refugees. The increase stems from the conflict in South Sudan, which has sent thousands over the Ethiopian border in search of safety.

7. Sub-Saharan Africa hosts roughly what percentage of global refugees?
- **25%**

Sub-Saharan Africa hosts 26% of the world's global refugee population - more than 18 million people. UNHCR has attributed the sharp increase to conflict in South Sudan, Central African Republic, Nigeria, and Burundi.

8. How many people died trying to cross the Mediterranean in 2015?

According to the International Organization for Migration (IOM), in 2015, 3 771 people died trying to cross the Mediterranean Sea in pursuit of peace and safety in Europe. 2015, was the deadliest year on record for migrant and refugee crossing in the Mediterranean. By May 2016, more than 2 000 people perished while attempting the dangerous journey.

9. How many people are displaced daily due to violence and persecution?
- 52 000

According to UNHCR, 33 972 people are forced to flee their homes because of violence and conflict globally.

10. Of the \$12 billion pledged to the Syrian refugee crisis, how much funding was committed?
- \$10 billion

A record of \$12,1 billion was pledged by several nations in early February at the London Conference. By May, less than \$1.2 billion had been committed according to a Concern Worldwide report.
