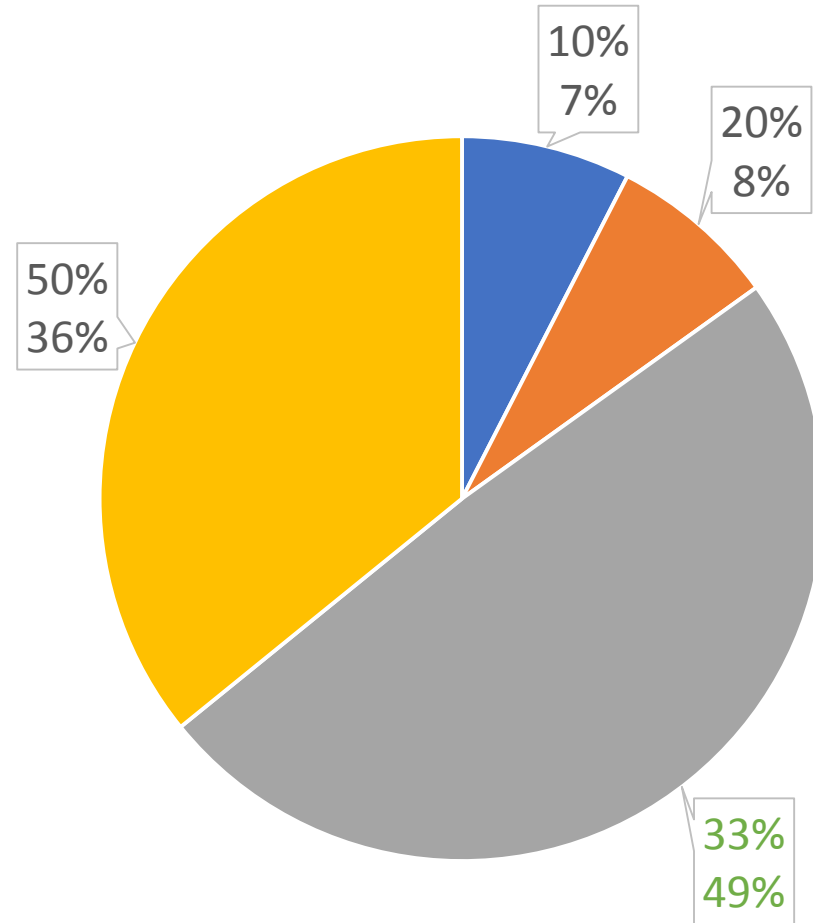


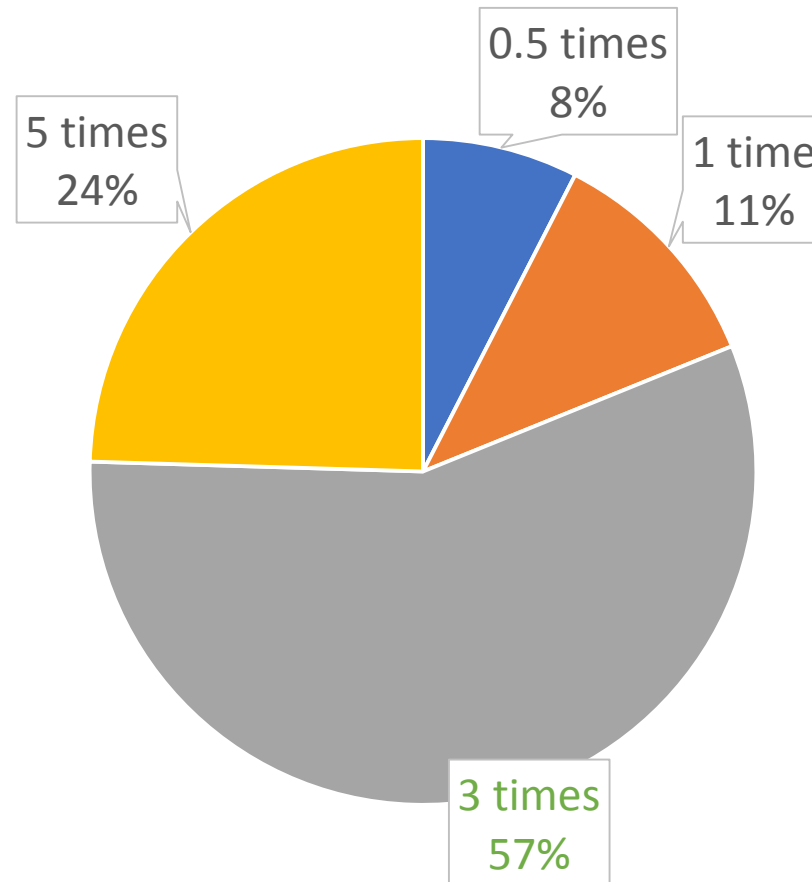

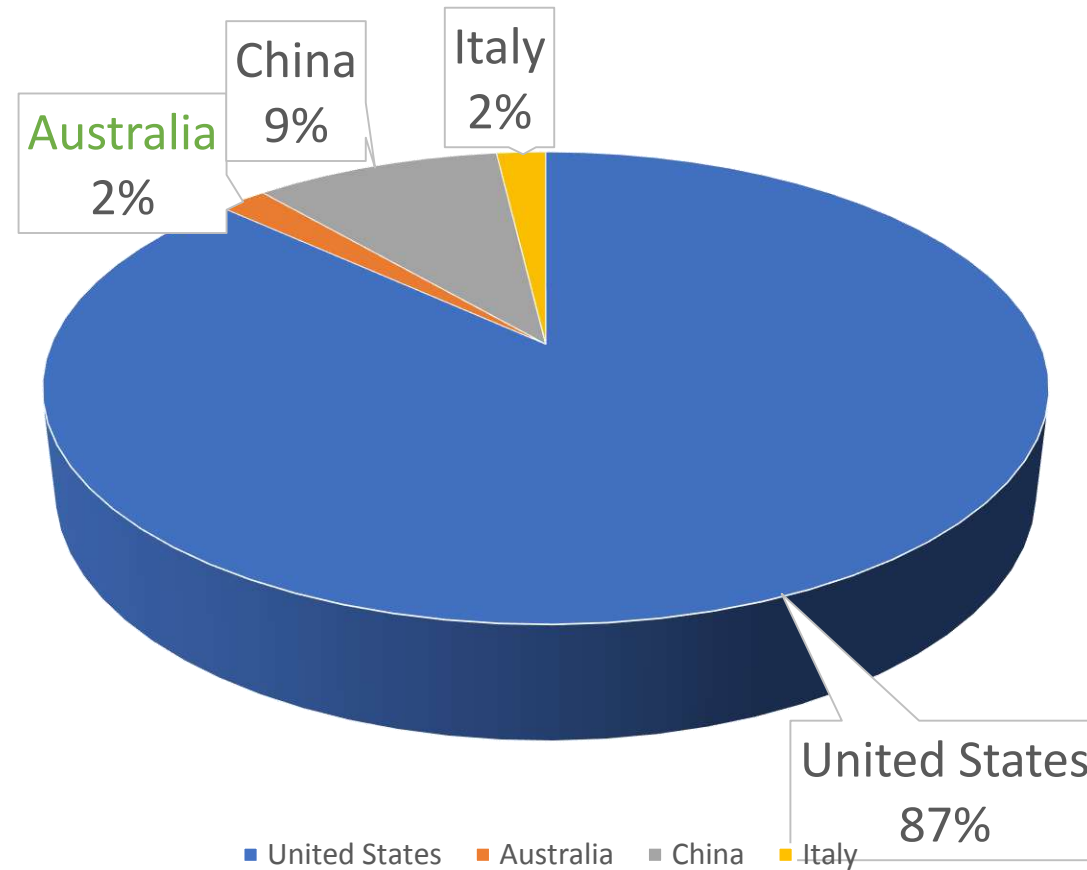
How much food do you think is wasted around the world?



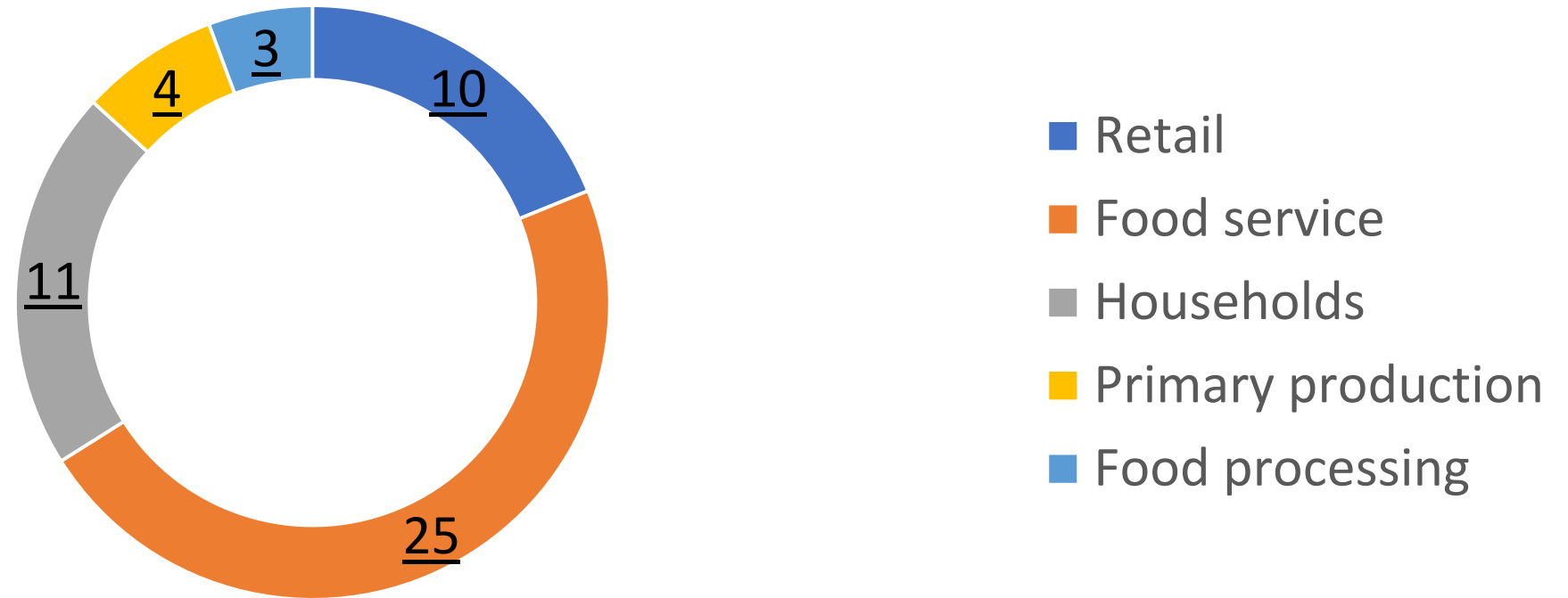
Europe and USA throw away 143 million tons of food every year. How many times you could feed the starving population with this food?

Which one of the following sectors wastes the most food?

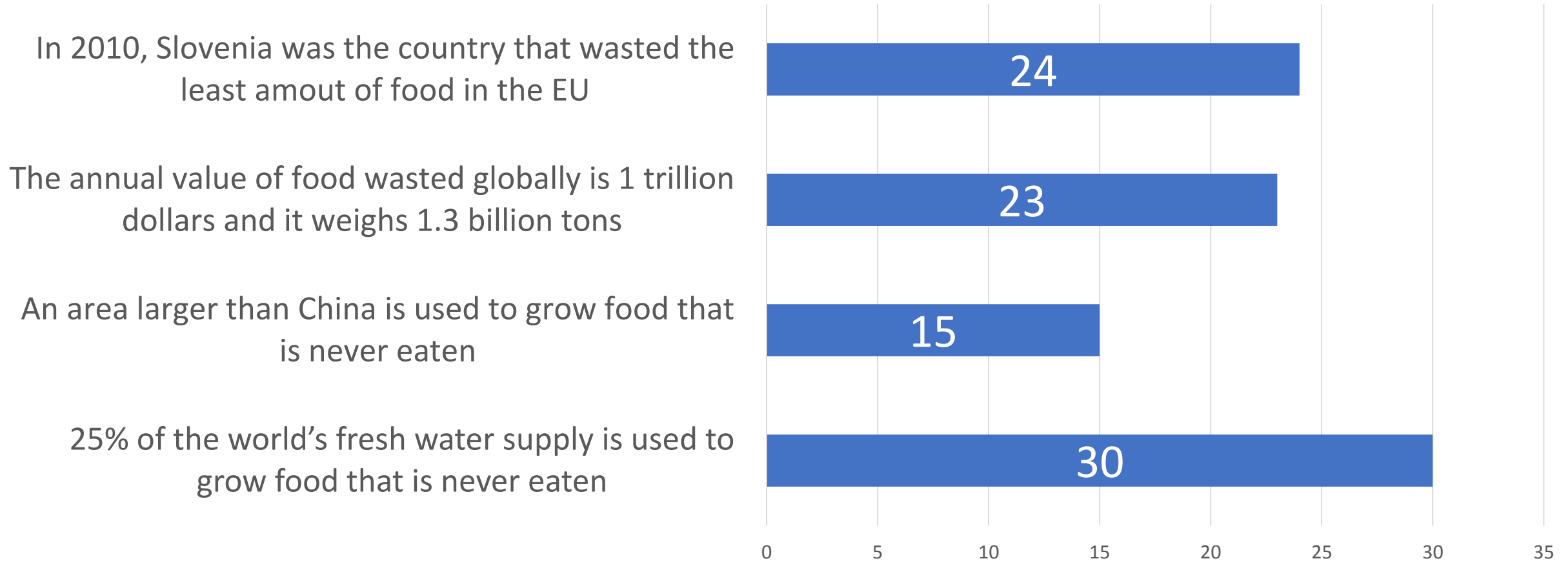


SHARE OF EU FOOD WASTE

(Estimates, 2012)

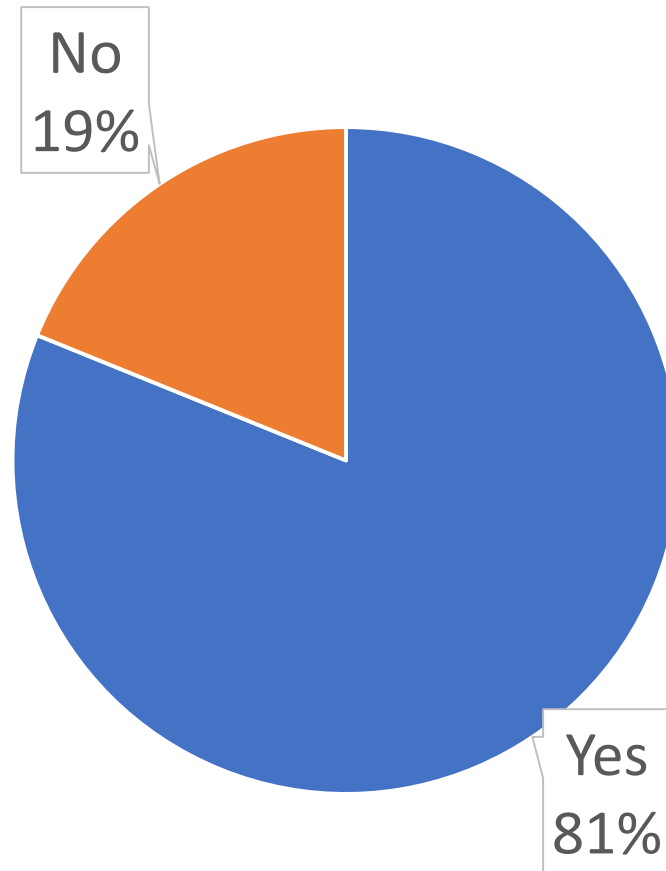
